IRA Contribution

For those 70 ½ years and older, as you celebrate your reunion, you can also give any amount (up to a maximum of \$111,000) per year from your IRA directly to a qualified charity such as Cedar Crest College without having to pay income taxes on the distribution. This popular gift option is commonly called the IRA charitable rollover, but you may also see it referred to as a qualified charitable distribution, or QCD for short. Feel good knowing that you are making a difference at the College, while celebrating this special milestone.
